Gospel (Luke 15:1-32) Through telling three parables about the lost and the found' Jesus explains his concern for sinners.

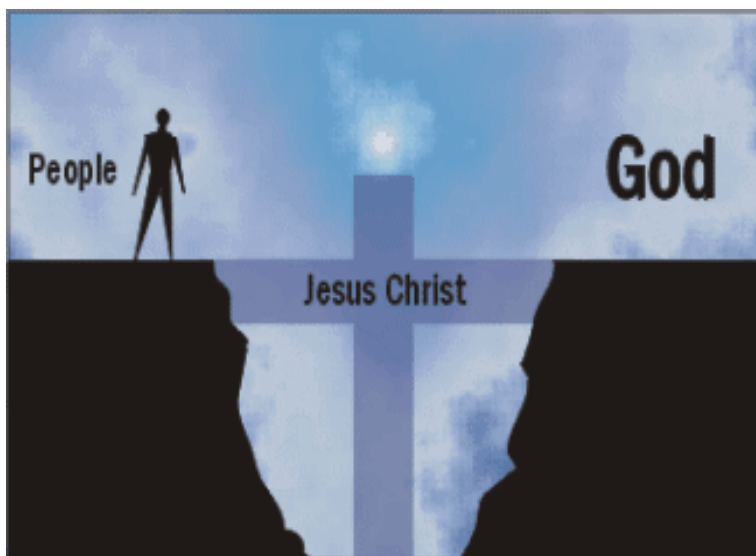
